Needs for children: curriculum researchers to help us find good material to teach; once-per-month teachers for Sunday morning [and willing substitutes]; female GEMS leaders; men willing to work with boys to start Stockade [the Christian Service Brigade program for boys in third through fifth grades]. Needs for youth: curriculum developers to help us research and write material for Sunday school; a young woman teacher to pair with Matt for Sunday school; event coordinators for our monthly fun large group events; female leaders for GEMS [or maybe a small group]; male leaders for CSB; several men willing to teach a particular skill or activity for a four-week period at CSB. Needs for adults: apprentice leaders for our small groups [to be trained to become small group leaders in the future]; mentors for new believers and new members; Sunday school teachers; people to visit, pray with, and encourage shut-ins and hospital patients; a young adults event coordinator; what else??? Scripture guides us to three key relationships [see graphic below]. [building up] one another involves having a people ministry and a task ministry, both teaching and serving. So start praying and thinking about how you can be involved in the ministry of the church!
